

# **Motion41 Dance Summer Intensive Accommodations**

#### **HOUSING**

Boarding students for the Motion41 Dance Summer Intensive will stay at **University Village** at the University of Nebraska at Omaha - Dodge Street campus. Each suite includes 4 bedrooms, a furnished living room, a full kitchen (dishwasher, stove, refrigerator), and two full baths. Each student will have their own bedroom that includes a twin bed, desk, chair, and dresser. University Village is fully air conditioned and features free wi-fi.

## **MEALS**

Student's meals will take place in a variety of venues. Each student will have their breakfast in their suite, utilizing the full kitchen and the grocery items that they have selected (\*completion of the "Breakfast Menu" form is required.) Dinner will take place at Scott Dining Hall at the University of Nebraska at Omaha - Pacific Street Campus. Scott Dining Hall is a full-service cafeteria. On dance days, sack lunches will be provided by Scott Dining Hall and enjoyed during the lunch break at the studio. On off days, lunch will take place at the Scott Dining Hall at the Pacific Street Campus. Sundays include a Brunch Service at Scott Dining, extended hours in late morning/early afternoon that encompass both meals. Students will also enjoy an off campus dinner meal on one of their excursions during the Summer Intensive.

## TRANSPORTATION

Students will be transported to/from the dance studios, dining hall, housing facility, and excursions by a licensed driver in methods that are in line with state and federal laws regarding passenger safety and accountability. When not in group transportation, students may be transported to certain activities by Motion41 Staff or Faculty members, or by designated adults.

#### **SUPERVISION**

Boarding students will have 24/7 supervision by a Resident Advisor through Motion41 Dance. The Resident Advisor(s) will be staying with the students at the housing facility. Resident Advisors will also accompany the students on excursions and trips to the dining hall. While at the studios, students will be under the care of Motion41 Dance faculty, staff, and Resident Advisor(s).

## **EXCURSIONS**

During the Summer Intensive program, students will also have the opportunity to experience a taste of the Omaha area through excursions to local sites or events. These activities will be supervised by the Resident Advisor(s) and include transportation. Excursions might include: a visit to Omaha's Henry Doorly Zoo, Westroads Mall, a College World Series of Baseball event, movies, and/or others.

# **MISCELLANEOUS SERVICES**

Free laundry facilities are located in the building adjacent to the students' suites, a few steps from their front door. Wifi is available throughout University Village. Vending machines for drinks and snacks are also located in the adjacent building. Bottled water is available for purchase at the studio for \$1. Any packages or mail for students should be sent to Motion41 Dance.

# **SUMMER INTENSIVE BOARDING FEES**

\$955.00 = 2 Week Program \$530.00 = 1 Week Program

This includes each student's room at the housing facility, all meals, transportation, supervision, and extra-curricular activities

\*For the safety of the students and to comply with housing facility rules, students can only board for 1 or 2 weeks, but not for individual days

\* Boarding students must be at least 12 years of age
