



Rules & Regulations

Both students and parents should read the following rules and regulations carefully. Students are expected to know these rules and abide by them while participating in Summer Programs. Failure to abide by these rules could result in dismissal at the discretion of the Motion41 Dance faculty and staff. After reading these rules carefully, please sign the attached "Rules & Regulations Agreement." Students will not be allowed to participate in the program until the agreement is signed and received by the Office at Motion41 Dance.

- Motion41 Dance will not tolerate any behavior that is detrimental to the welfare, emotional well-being, or safety of others or self.
- Motion41 Dance is a smoke-free community. Possession or use of any tobacco products by program participants is strictly prohibited both on and off site and will result in dismissal.
- The possession, use, distribution, sale, or transfer of any illegal drugs, alcohol, tobacco products, or related paraphernalia will be grounds for immediate dismissal from the program. Being in the presence of any drugs, alcohol, or related paraphernalia is in itself an infraction of this rule. As a condition of enrollment in Summer Programs, every student agrees to test for alcohol and drugs whenever there is a reasonable cause to suspect that the student is under the influence. Refusal to cooperate with the testing will be deemed as admission that a violation has occurred.
- For the safety of all, students are prohibited from possessing, taking, or dispensing any medication without the direct supervision of a Motion41 Staff Member. All medications, including over-the-counter drugs and vitamins, must be left with Motion41 Staff when the student arrives on their first day.
- Televisions, microwaves, portable air conditioners or refrigerators are not permitted in student rooms. These items are in the common room area and accessible at all times while in housing.
- Students may not alter, destroy, or deface property at Motion41 Dance or the housing facility. Dormitory rooms and fixtures, furniture, studios, common areas, other student-shared items such as laundry facilities, soda machines, etc. are to be treated with respect and care. Problems with any of these areas must be reported to a Resident Advisor or a Motion41 Dance Staff member. Students are not allowed to move additional furniture or appliances into or out of the housing facility.
- Students, when off campus, are expected to conduct themselves in accordance with the policies and standards established by the school. Having chosen to belong to the Motion41 Dance community, all students are expected to act responsibly whether on or off campus. The school reserves the right to address unacceptable behavior that occurs off campus at any time.
- Proper behavior must be maintained in the dining hall. No food, dishes, trays, or utensils may be taken from the dining hall at any time. Students are expected to use said items in their proper manner and pick up after themselves accordingly. Students must be appropriately dressed in the dining hall; shirt and shoes are required by health and safety regulations.
- **Dress Code:** While on and off site, students may dress informally during non-dance activities (please the Intensive brochure for dance class dress code.) Bathing suits, dirty or torn clothing, clothes with offensive messages, and sleepwear are not appropriate for the studio space, dining hall, or other areas outside the dormitory. Students are not permitted to appear in public, whether on the housing site or outside the studio area, wearing only their leotard and tights. Shorts, shirts, or other "cover-ups" must be used at all times.

- **Visitors:** There are no visiting privileges for opposite genders in the dormitories. Students are not allowed under any circumstances to visit dormitories designated for students of the opposite gender. Visitors to the housing site, except for adult family members, are not permitted in any dormitory at any time. Visitors to the housing site must be approved by the Programming Director if on campus for more than 1 hour.
- **Student Vehicles:** Boarding students are not permitted to have cars or any other motorized vehicles on the housing campus or at Motion41 Dance. Day students are not permitted to visit the housing site for boarding students. Day students may use their own vehicle to get to/from Motion41 Dance and have access to free parking (daytime only) while at Motion41 Dance. Boarding students are not permitted to ride with Day student drivers at any time.
- **Leaving Campus:** Students are not allowed to leave the dormitory without a Motion41 Staff member or Resident Advisor. Boarding students are not permitted to leave the Motion41 Dance site without a Staff Member or Resident Advisor. Students are not allowed to leave the housing site or Motion41 Dance without permission from the Programming Director (except for official Summer Intensive outing/activities with Motion41 Staff.) Day students age 18 or over do not need to obtain permission to leave campus. Permission is obtained by submitting a written, signed notice from the parent on the student's behalf. Students are expected to attend all scheduled classes, rehearsals, and performances, regardless of visiting hours. Boarding students are not allowed to leave campus overnight for the duration of the program. Boarding students may leave campus with their families or other adults with whom they have permission, but must be back at the housing site by curfew.
- **Curfews:** Appointed Resident Advisors are on duty 24 hours a day. Students may not be late for curfew. In-Room curfew is 10:30 p.m. Sunday through Thursday, and 12:00 a.m. on Friday and Saturday. Common Room lights are turned off at this time, and students are expected to be in their own rooms maintaining a quiet atmosphere. Students should have completed their bathroom use, and there is no pay-phone or cell phone use after this hour. Compliance with the "In-Room" curfew is essential for the well-being of the students and their success in the program. If students are late for check-in or are out of their rooms after curfew, they will have to check in earlier the following night. If they are more than fifteen minutes late, they will be required to meet with the Programming Director and parents may be contacted. Repeated lateness or dorm disruption is disrespectful to the community and will be taken seriously, possibly resulting in dismissal from the program.
- **Cellular Phones:** It is strongly encouraged that each student have a cell phone while in attendance. Personal cell phone use is permitted in the dormitory rooms, dormitory common room, and common areas at Motion41 Dance only. Cell phones being used outside of these designated areas will be confiscated. Additionally, cell phone use that a Resident Advisor believes to be disruptive to other students or an individual's success in the program may result in the phone being taken from the student and held by the Programming Director. Students are not permitted to have cell phones in the studios at any time. Students are permitted and encouraged to carry cell phones when off campus.
- **Computers/Email:** Students are permitted to have laptop computers or tablet devices with them during the program. These are to be used in the same designated areas as cell phones. WiFi is available both at the housing site and Motion41 Dance. Motion41 Dance is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged personal computers.
- **Keys/Safety:** Some boarding students may be issued a key to their dormitory room. Students/Parents must submit a \$75 key deposit by check when arriving on the first day. If the key is not lost or damaged during the program, the check will be returned to the student/parent. If the key is lost or damaged, they check will be cashed for its replacement.

MOTION41 DANCE IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR LOST, STOLEN, OR DAMAGED PROPERTY.

- **Fire Safety and Guidelines:** Smoking or use of fire of any kind, such as candles, incense, open flames, heated appliances or flammable items at any time while in the program is strictly prohibited and will result in automatic expulsion from the program. These restrictions include, but are not limited to, heating coils, hot pots, space heaters, coffeepots, or any other heat producing device such as curling irons, halogen lamps, kerosene lamps, matches, lighters, or any decorative lighting. In addition, flammable materials such as paper posters, cloth tapestries or ropes may not be hung from the walls or ceiling in the dormitories. There may be unannounced room inspections by the Resident Advisor and/or Motion41 Staff to ensure compliance with these regulations. All mattresses must be on bed frames with legs and cannot be placed directly on the floor. Entrances to rooms must be clear of any obstructions, and access must be free to door and emergency procedures require immediate access to any room occupied by a student or leading to emergency fire exits. Should fire or emergency drills be conducted, absolute cooperation is required.
